BACKGROUND

Thanks to this unique private-public interaction, INNODIA has become the largest European research and clinical project ever started dedicated to helping people living with type 1 diabetes. The INNODIA project has shown how academic researchers and clinicians, industry and patients can effectively collaborate to defeat type 1 diabetes. To guarantee continuity and expansion of this successful research and clinical network, INNODIA has been transformed into a legal entity with the MISSION to facilitate the development of new cures and promote disease modifying therapies for people living with type 1 diabetes, everywhere.
